

## ABSTRACT FORMAT FOR THE ICRS SYMPOSIUM ON THE CANNABINOIDS

**Introduction:** This abstract provides the instructions on the format to be used when submitting your abstract to the Symposium on the Cannabinoids conference.

**Methods:** The abstract should be 250 words or less. Margins should be at least 1” on all sides of the page. Type font should be Times New Roman, 12 point. The title should appear at the top, centred, all in CAPS and bold. Author names should appear below the title and centered. Each author’s name should appear as a first name, middle initial(s), if applicable and then last name. A superscript numeral should designate the author’s affiliation/organization and an asterisk designates the presenting author. Abstracts should have the following 4 sections bolded: Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusions.

**Results:** The results section must include a description of the results that will be presented at the conference (and, ideally, actual data and details of statistical analysis). It is not acceptable to write vague statements such as ‘data will be presented in the general area of xxxxxx’.

**Conclusions:** Your abstract should be a concise summary of your study and its results, whether it is intended for presentation in either oral or poster format at the conference. Abstract submissions must be one-page in length, saved in one of the following document formats: Microsoft Word (.doc,.docx), Rich Text (.rtf). If there are figures or tables in your abstract and/or presentation, you must INSERT them into your abstract (Do not drag-and-drop graphics).

You must be an ICRS Member-in-Good-Standing to present data at our Symposia, and you must also register for the entire Symposium.
